WHEREAS it is enacted by <u>section 40</u> (1) of the <u>Diplomatic Relations and Immunities Act 1967</u> (No. 8 of 1967) that the Government may by order designate an international organisation, community or body of which the State or the Government is or intends to become a member to be an organisation to which Part VIII of that Act applies;

AND WHEREAS the State intends to become a member of the International Organisation of Vine and Wine;

NOW the Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by <u>section 40</u> of the <u>Diplomatic</u> <u>Relations and Immunities Act 1967</u>, hereby order as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the International Organisation of Vine and Wine (Designation Order 2002.
- 2. The International Organisation of Vine and Wine is hereby designated to be an organisation to which Part VIII of the <u>Diplomatic Relations and Immunities Act 1967</u> (No. 8 of 1967 applies.
